Paul Green Foundation Storage Closet Holdings

Located in the former Chapel Hill Museum at 523 E. Franklin St.

Many artifacts accumulated during Paul Green's long lifetime –

– copies of the books he wrote, unpublished manuscripts of stories and plays, reference books, numerous photographs from his personal and writing life including pictures of the construction of his 17 outdoor drama amphitheatres. Countless awards: Honorary Doctorate hoods and certificates from nine universities are in the Closet along with awards for Pulitzer Prize, Belasco Cup, Guggenheim Fellowships, Fellow of the American Letters of the Library of Congress, Freedom Foundation Medals, National Honorary Theatre Fraternity, North Carolina Award for Literature, UNC Distinguished Alumnus, Dramatist Laureate of North Carolina, Albert Schweitzer Medal for Artistry, Paul Green Theatre dedication, Broadway Theatre Hall of Fame, North Carolina Literary Hall of Fame Hall...and many more.

Since 1982, with the establishment of the Paul Green Foundation, additional materials have accumulated

from the work of the Foundation and we realized it was time to move select document files to a more secure location and to a place where researchers could make use of them. The **UNC Southern Historical Collection** – where the **Paul Green Papers** are in repository – was just the place!
