## ODETS THE SILENT PARTNER

The ReGroup Ensemble is hosting a gala with the showing of Clifford Odets, *The Silent Partner* – a play that has never been performed. *The Silent Partner* was originally written for production by the Group Theatre but the company sadly closed its doors before the play was ever mounted. Often referred to as a long-form version of *Waiting for Lefty* as it deals with striking workers, it is an entirely original and "savagely poetic" three-Act tale that only Odets could tell.

The Silent Partner will be presented on Monday,

**July 15th**, 2013 at the Players Club, 16 Gramercy Park South, NYC. The evening will begin with an open bar reception from 7pm - 8, followed by the 8 p.m. staged reading of this rare play.
